The DESEO Project, funded by the EU, is a transnational project led by REVES (Network of the Cities and Regions of the Social Economy). It aims to carry out a series of local actions around the theme of promoting access to economic and social opportunities for women and other disadvantaged groups.

The Project brings together Partnerships in seven European Regions. An Irish DESEO Partnership was formed in West Cork in March of this year, led by Carbery Housing Association, a community based housing association Cork County Development Board, West Cork LEADER Co-operative and Clann Credo, an ethical financial institution.

The DESEO project believes that the local application of the promotion of social enterprises, and the clustering of these enterprises, is an effective way of promoting the integration of women and other excluded groups into the economic, cultural and social life of the region

The West Cork DESEO Partnership will continue to operate until February 2008, developing a work programme aimed at promoting this objective. To date, it has carried out a survey to identify social economy enterprises working in the region, set up meetings with interested parties and is developing proposals for future support for the sector

In order to consult these findings, we have put together a Seminar that brings together examples of enterprises and entrepreneurs and of the agencies and programmes that support them, in Ireland, Northern Ireland and other parts of Europe. The Seminar will be held in **Jury's Hotel, Western Road, Cork City** on Monday 26th of November. It will also include an exhibition of the work of the sector. Attendance is free, but a charge of €15 will be made for lunch & coffee. A charge of €25 will apply to organisations or individuals wishing to exhibit.
